**SDK COMMENTS:** Financial turnaround continues under Copeland's leadership. Good to see that The Campaign 300 (meaning 300 student leaders graduate annually) numbers are up 263 versus 101 in 2014, as the campaign wraps up this year. No mention of capital/campus improvement needs in the narrative despite long-time discussion of such.

I may want to meet Jim Otteson, Director of the Eudaimonia Institute at Wake Forest, if time allows in April, given the support he has received from ISI over last year's controversy (well covered in the EF last year). But certainly not necessary.

I had a good conversation with Copeland last April ("touch" is attached). I would think he is anticipating a further modest decline in our support as we move toward the \$100K type level (I am surprised by the grant request size given our conversation). So, will recommend renewed general operating support of \$125K, despite our target of \$135K and suggest budgeting at \$115K for next year.
